Join Foot Patrol

What is Foot Patrol?

Foot Patrol is a program sponsored by the City of Portland's Office of Neighborhood Involvement. It is a community-based neighborhood walking group that collaborates with city programs and services to help identify and address neighborhood problems. Don't let the word "patrol" fool you- volunteers are not expected to be law enforcement- foot patrols are just extra eyes and ears in the community.

How does it work?

Foot Patrol walks are scheduled on weekend evenings and generally last 90 minutes. Volunteers sign up for a couple of walks each month. You will walk with 3 or 4 other community members. Initially, you can participate in Foot Patrol by walking with one of our experienced, trained members. This way you can give it a try and see if it is something you enjoy. We will arrange a training for new volunteers, but you don't need to complete the training to get started.
